We do not provide ESL or translation services. If English is not the student's primary language, and the student is unable to understand the terms and conditions of the Enrollment Agreement, the student shall have the right to obtain a clear explanation of the terms and conditions and all cancellation and refund policies in his or her primary language.

Our classes are offered at 1670 S Amphlett Blvd, San Mateo, CA 94402. All online classes are done through a real-time, virtual interactive classroom. The student must attend online for all 45 hours.

Students may enroll for only certain classes rather than the entire program. This is to meet individual needs for employment under California Title 22 Licensing requirements. 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STUDENT TUITION RECOVERY FUND (STRF)

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TUITION REFUND POLICY

The institution shall refund the unused portion of tuition fees and other charges if the student does not register for the period of attendance or withdraws there from at any time prior to completion of the course, or otherwise fails to complete the period of enrollment. The institutional refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the course of instruction shall be a pro-rated refund.

The refund shall be calculated as follows:

- 1. Deduct a registration fee
- 2. If applicable deduct the STRF
- 3. Divide this figure by the number of hours in the program.
- 4. The quotient is the hourly charge for the program.
- 5. The amount owed by the student for the purpose of calculation a refund is derived by multiplying the total hours attended by the hourly charge for instruction plus the amount of the registration fee.
- 6. The refund shall be any amount in excess of the figure derived that was paid by the student.

This institution does not provide State or Federal financial aid.
